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COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

The compositions indicated correspond to the frame formulations representative of the product category, as defined at European level by a group of experts composed of representatives of poison control centers, competent authorities, business associations, and the services of the European Commission.

The frame formulations are provided for by Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 for the electronic notification of cosmetic products through the Cosmetic Product Notification Portal (CPNP), carried out pursuant to Article 13.

The frame formulations (available in the user manual for notification via the CPNP at http://ec.europa.eu/consumers/sectors/cosmetics/cpnp/index_en.htm) specify the types of ingredients and their maximum concentrations, enabling the rapid identification of products.

HAZARD IDENTIFICATION

When used according to the manufacturer's instructions, the product is safe for humans and the environment. The following information is relevant in cases of improper use or accident.

The use of suitable gloves is recommended for professionals using these products in hair salons.

Irritating to eyes and skin. Harmful if swallowed. May cause an allergic skin reaction. Risk of inhalation of vapors into the respiratory tract. Do not breathe vapors. Use only in well-ventilated areas. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact with eyes, remove contact lenses if present and easy to do, then rinse immediately with water and consult a specialist.

Do not apply if the client has previously experienced allergic reactions to perming lotions or if the scalp is sensitized, irritated, or damaged. Protect the face.

Immediately blot any perming lotion that may drip using an absorbent tissue. Do not reuse towels previously soaked with perming lotion. After the processing time has elapsed, rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water.

Do not perform the perm on hair treated with colorings based on metallic salts or straightened with an alkaline cream based on sodium hydroxide or with products containing potassium hydroxide, lithium hydroxide, or guanidine carbonate. Do not apply the product on hair that has been bleached more than 40–50%. Wait 15 days after applying a permanent hair color before performing a perming service. Wait 15 days before applying an oxidative hair color to freshly permed hair.

Keep out of reach of children. Do not eat, drink, or smoke during use.

PROSHAPE WAVESELF 1S, 1 and 2 contain thioglycolates.



FIRST AID MEASURES

Measures in case of:

Accidental contact with eyes: Rinse cautiously for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Consult a specialist.

Accidental ingestion of large quantities of product: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Contact a poison control center.

Discomfort due to skin contact with undiluted product: Wash thoroughly with water. If skin irritation or rash occurs, seek medical advice. Wash contaminated clothing before reusing.

Massive inhalation: Move the affected person to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing.

FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

In case of fire, use water spray, dry chemical powder, or carbon dioxide.

ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Collect the spilled product with a cloth and wash the contaminated areas thoroughly with plenty of water.

Never return spilled product to the original container.

Never reuse spilled product.

HANDLING AND STORAGE

Store in dry and well-ventilated areas (room temperature).

Do not store or use the product near open flames, heat sources, or direct sunlight (the product may deteriorate).

Do not store the product at temperatures below 5°C (41°F).

Close the container tightly after use.

Do not use the product for purposes other than those intended and indicated in the instructions for use.

Keep out of reach of children.



PERSONAL PROTECTION / EXPOSURE CONTROL

The workplace must be adequately ventilated, if necessary by mechanical air exchange (Title II of Legislative Decree 81/2008 and subsequent amendments). Areas where vapors, gases, dust, or substance spills may occur must be set up in separate zones equipped with local exhaust ventilation systems or collection systems (Annex IV, point 2 of Legislative Decree 81/2008 and subsequent amendments).

If the Employer identifies risks that cannot be avoided or sufficiently reduced by other means, they are required to provide workers with appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) (Articles 75 and 77 of Legislative Decree 81/2008 and subsequent amendments).

PPE must comply with the provisions set out in Legislative Decree 475/1992 and subsequent amendments (Article 76 of Legislative Decree 81/2008).

The use of PPE provided by the Employer is mandatory (Articles 20, paragraph 2, and 78 of Legislative Decree 81/2008 and subsequent amendments).

STABILITY AND REACTIVITY

Stable at room temperature.

DISPOSAL CONSIDERATIONS

With regard to the disposal of cosmetic products, the applicable legislation is Part Four of Legislative Decree 152/2006 (Environmental Code) and subsequent amendments.

For disposal purposes, non-hazardous waste deriving from artisanal activities (in the case of a hairdressing or beauty salon, empty used bottles or containers) may be treated as municipal waste if the relevant Municipality has implemented the provisions set out in Article 198 of Legislative Decree 152/2006, which defines municipal responsibilities. Only empty bottles should be delivered for recycling.



Under Part Three, Section II, Titles III and IV of Legislative Decree 152/2006 concerning water protection, and in accordance with regional provisions, professional hairdressing activities may be classified as civil establishments whose wastewater may be considered equivalent to domestic wastewater and discharged into the sewer system as such, provided that they comply with regulations issued by local authorities (e.g., Municipalities and Consortia) managing the public sewer system.

REGULATORY INFORMATION

Finished cosmetic products are manufactured and marketed in compliance with Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 and subsequent amendments.

Finished cosmetic products are specifically excluded from the scope of European Union legislation on hazardous substances and mixtures (Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008). They are also excluded from the provisions of Title IV of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.

If the Risk Assessment (Article 28 of Legislative Decree 81/2008) determines that health surveillance is required, the Employer must appoint a competent occupational physician (Article 18, paragraph 1, letter a)) to subject workers to the pre-employment and periodic medical examinations provided for by law (Article 41 of Legislative Decree 81/2008). Workers are required to undergo the health surveillance prescribed by the competent physician (Articles 20 and 78 of Legislative Decree 81/2008).
